

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Nature and Purpose of Award

The UNCW Award for Faculty Scholarship is designed to underscore this institution's continuing commitment to scholarship and creative work. Recipients of the award shall stand out among the faculty as persons who have made, and continue to make, a significant contribution to the university and the academic community through their commitment to scholarship, research, and creativity.

The \$1500 award brings both honor and responsibility to the recipient(s). It recognizes a member of the faculty as a person of excellence, and calls upon the person so honored to share that excellence with colleagues, students, and the community.

Criteria for Consideration

A nominee for the Award for Faculty Scholarship must be a current full-time member of the UNCW faculty. A nominee must have exhibited genuine interest in scholarship, research, and creativity; earned the respect of colleagues and peers; maintained high standards of quality and integrity; fostered interest and involvement of students and colleagues in scholarship and creative work; and demonstrated a significant contribution to scholarship, research, and creativity at UNCW.

Procedure for Nominations

Nominations may be submitted by any member of the UNCW faculty. All letters of nomination are limited to one page and must indicate how the nominee satisfies the criteria for consideration. Nominations must be received in the chancellor's office no later than March 31, 2008.

Selection Process

The chancellor will appoint members of a selection committee, which will include the Chair of the University Research Committee, immediate past recipient(s) of this award, and additional members as recommended by the President of the Faculty Senate. After review of the nominations, this committee will solicit additional information about the nominees and, depending on the number and quality of nominees, will recommend to the chancellor up to three recipients.

Announcement of Recipient

The recipient(s) of the 2008 UNCW Award for Faculty Scholarship will be announced by the President of the Faculty Senate at the fall faculty meeting.
