

The Center for Marine Science Faculty Research Stipends Award

A. Purpose

Marine Science Research Stipends provide summer funding to faculty conducting research in marine biotechnology, marine biomedical and environmental physiology, coastal and estuarine studies, oceanography, or marine geology. The stipends promote research that will encourage external funding and that will support the missions of the Center for Marine Science Research and of the university.

B. Award and Activities

Each award provides a faculty member with a stipend during June (or any 30-day period between May 15 and June 30) or July (or any 30-day period between July 1 and August 15). The stipend shall be equal to 1/9 of the faculty member's salary for the academic year preceding the period of the stipend, up to a maximum of \$4500. Normally, a faculty member may receive only one stipend per summer, but an exception may be made for a faculty member who serves as a program coordinator or who has received a funded grant that includes matching funds for two months of summer stipends. No faculty member may receive more than two stipends during a single summer. Award amounts are subject to change from year to year.

Activities may include the initiation, continuation, or completion of a marine research project. Other types of appropriate activities include grant proposal development and collaboration with faculty from NCSU or other universities on research supporting the cooperative Ph.D. in marine sciences. The Director of the Center for Marine Science Research, in consultation with the Marine Science Advisory Committee, may announce funding priorities prior to the call for stipend requests.

C. Eligibility

To be eligible, the applicant must be a full-time nine-month continuing faculty member.
