## Summer 2009 Information/Summer Housing

Both Summer I and Summer II charges are due May 19, 2009, including Summer housing charges posted to your account. Failure to pay will result in:

If taking Summer courses, your Summer courses will be dropped.

If not taking Summer courses, a registration hold will be placed on your account which will prevent you from changing your Fall registration.

\*\*Students are **not** eligible for Financial Aid until they have taken six summer hours. Financial Aid students taking three credit hours in Summer I and three credit hours in Summer II will not have their classes dropped for Summer I non-payment.

## E-bill Announcements

- Fall 2009 pre-registration E-bills will be generated in early July and will be due August 6, 2009. Students and Authorized Users will receive an email when the E-bill is available. Again, summer bills are due May 19, 2009.
- To view charges, make payment with a credit card or checking/savings account, and to setup your parents as an authorized user, login to E-bill at:

- Payments made online will post immediately and eliminate stress caused by mailing delays.

## E-refunds – New Refund Process

Effective July 1, electronic refunds will be issued directly from the University into your checking or savings account. Higher One will no longer be used to issue student refunds. Students will need to enter their bank account information into SeaNet/E-bill to receive any excess funds from loans, overpayments, scholarships and grant monies. The electronic refund system is safe and secure.
