Chinese Course Descriptions

(Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures)

CHN 101. Introductory Chinese I (3) Emphasis on achievement of an active command of the language. Aural-oral practice; intensive study of the basic pattern of spoken Mandarin; reading, writing, and basic conversation. For students with one unit or less of high school Chinese.

CHN 102. Introductory Chinese II (3) Prerequisite: CHN 101. Emphasis on achievement of an active command of the language. Aural-oral practice; intensive study of the basic pattern of spoken Mandarin; reading, writing, and basic conversation. Only for students who have successfully completed CHN 101.
