- ❖ Designed for middle and high school science teachers and graduate students with undergraduate degrees outside the discipline.
- ❖ Developed and taught by **science faculty** from the College of Arts and Sciences at UNCW, **master teachers** from local middle and high schools, and UNCW **graduate students**.
- ❖ Students may be either degree seeking or non-degree seeking graduate students.
- ❖ Courses satisfy science requirements for Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) and Masters of Education (MEd) graduate programs in science offered by the Watson School of Education.
- ❖ Instructors and students will be provided with **Tablet PCs** for the duration of their involvement in the program.
- ❖ The program is made possible through a partnership between the Watson School of Education and the College of Arts and Sciences, University of North Carolina Wilmington.
