

What to Wear and Bring to Camp O.C.E.A.N.S. and Oceans 17

Summer weather in Wilmington is typically hot (85-100 degrees) and humid. MarineQuest activities are planned with this in mind and err on the side of caution by scheduling indoor programs and having alternative plans to accommodate for rain or extreme heat.

What to Bring:

- Waterproof sunscreen (SPF 15 +)
- Water bottle (2)
- Bug spray
- Hat with visor
- Small hand-held fan
- Two towels for outdoor use
- Sweatshirt or light jacket or rain coat/poncho
- Water-proof bags for wet/dirty clothes
- Two pair of closed-toed field shoes
 - water shoes
 - old sneakers
 - Note that although the “croc” style clog with ankle strap is very popular campers have a difficult time keeping them on when we explore the marsh and it becomes a safety issue.
- Bed linens
 - pillow(s)
 - set of twin XL sheets
 - blanket or sleeping bag
- Two bath towels for dorm use
- Bathing suit(s)
 - Girls should wear **modest swim suits** plus a t-shirt for sun protection
 - Boys should wear **swim trunks** plus a t-shirt for sun protection
- Toiletry items including soothing lotion for sunburn and bug bites
- Medications to be stored with camp director
- Seven changes of field clothes
 - t-shirt
 - shorts
 - socks
 - underwear
- Seven changes of everyday clothes
 - shirt
 - shorts and at least one pair of pants
 - socks
 - underwear
- One pair of every day summer shoes
- All campers are required to wear some type of pajamas in the dorms.

Optional Items

- Snacks
- \$25-50 spending money
- Waterproof camera
- Waterproof watch

Campers will need to bring laundry detergent (unless flying) to do their laundry while at this two-week camp. If you are arriving by airplane we will have laundry detergent available for you to use. Just remind us!
