Praxis II Tests for Elementary Education Licensure Candidates- CRITICAL NOTICE:

If a student (December 2011) graduate has NOT taken and passed the 5011 (or 0011) AND 0012 tests by November 15, 2011 then:

NEW Elementary Test 5015 "Elementary Education: Instructional Practice and Applications" for NC must be taken:

- Computer based (only). No more paper based tests for Elementary Ed.
- During specific testing windows only in November, January, March, May & July
- Pre-registration required. Done on-line only during specific windows (next pre-registration begins Nov. 7th)

- Test duration is 2 hours

Upcoming November Praxis II Tests for Elementary Educations (k-6, NC) Candidates:

November 16-November 19 ONLY:

- Pre-registration required. Pre-registration ONLINE only, beginning November 7, 2011
- Testing at two local centers (via computer delivery only. No paper based tests in the future):
 - UNCW DePaolo Hall, Room 1021, 962-7444 (Monday- Friday)
 - Prometric Testing Center , 4900 Randal Parkway, Building A (Wilmington) ,392-0891 (Monday- Saturday)
- We expect tests to fill up quickly, and testing centers to be full for the 4 days of testing in November. Students should pre-register quickly to ensure a spot.

Future tests will be given during specific testing windows, via the above testing centers in January, March, May & July. Dates TBA (www.ets.org)

PRAXIS II REQUIREMENTS

The following tests should be taken the semester prior to student teaching (undergraduates and licensure-only students), or during the final semester in the program (graduate students). Students required to take Praxis II are Elementary Education and Special Education. Middle Grades students must take Praxis II if they have less than 24 hours of content in the licensure area. Please check with your advisor to ensure that you are taking the tests required for your licensure area.
