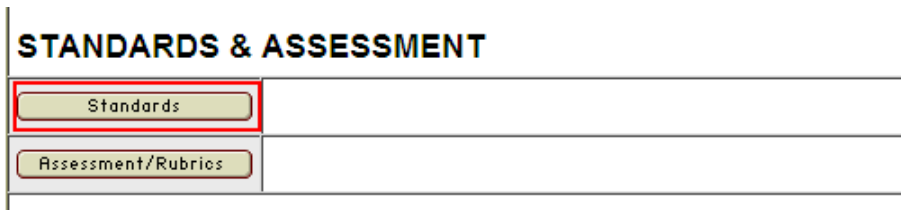
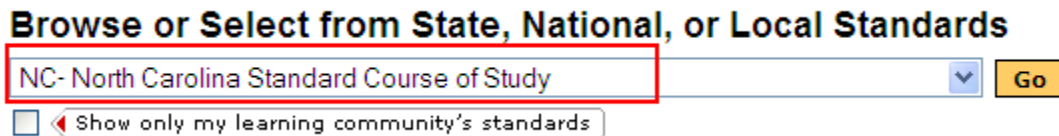


How to Add State and National Standards to your Lesson

1. Log into your Taskstream account.
2. Click on the **Lesson, Units, and Rubrics** tab at the top of the screen.
3. Click on the link **Go to Lesson Builder**.
4. Either create a new lesson or select an already created lesson from the archive list.
5. Scroll down to the section titled: **Standards and Assessment** and click on the **Standards** button.



6. Select the state, national or local standards from the list and then **click GO**. For example:



7. Locate the subject your lesson pertains too and click on the **Go to Next Level** button to the right of your subject title.

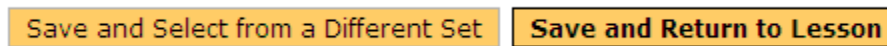

10. The select the objectives that pertain to your lesson by clicking in the radio button beside the objective.
