



B.A Criminology and Criminal Justice Criminology Option

The University of North Carolina Wilmington, Onslow Extension Program, in partnership with the North Carolina Community College System, offers a Bachelor of Arts in Criminology and Criminal Justice that can be completed entirely in Jacksonville, NC. Students may choose from one of two options: Criminal Justice or Criminology.

Online and face-to-face courses are available and offered in Jacksonville at Coastal Carolina Community College and at the John A. Lejeune Education Center aboard Camp Lejeune. Area residents, military, and military dependents have access to these courses.

Career Opportunities in Criminology

The Criminology Program at UNCW provides students with a strong social science foundation. Graduates are prepared to directly enter the profession in fields such as corrections, probation and parole, or police services. The rigorous curriculum empowers students with a deep understanding of the justice system and an appreciation of American society and its diversity. Many graduates find employment opportunities in various social service agencies related to the justice field. Some graduates work directly with adult or juvenile offenders. The BA degree prepares students for graduate programs in criminology and other related areas.

UNCW Application Information

- Prospective students must meet criteria for admission to UNCW and must apply through the normal application process. View the admissions website www.uncw.edu/admissions for details.
- Students may transfer a maximum of 64 semester hour credits from two-year institutions or a maximum of 93 semester credit hours from four-year institutions.
- Students admitted to UNCW Extension degree programs, as extension transfer students, must have completed a minimum of 24 college credits (from any college in the North Carolina Community College System or other accredited institutions).
- Application deadline is: **March 1** for Summer and Fall classes and **November 1** for Spring classes.
