The Extension Program has offices located at Coastal Carolina Community College, MCB Camp Lejeune, and MCAS New River.

Classes are held at Camp the Lejeune Education Center (civilians welcome on base), Coastal Carolina Community College, and online. Day, evening, and online classes are offered (class formats and schedules vary per academic program).

Financial Aid & Veterans Services

UNCW's **Financial Aid & Veterans Service Office** administers federal, state, and institutional student financial aid programs. Financial assistance is offered to students in the form of scholarships, grants, loans, Federal Work-Study jobs, or a combination of these programs.

Financial Aid

To apply for financial aid, a student must file a **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**.

The FAFSA is the only financial aid application required for the regular school year (fall and spring semesters). An additional institutional application (available on the UNCW Financial Aid & Veterans Affairs website) is required for summer semesters.

Students should file the FAFSA as soon as possible after January 1. The FAFSA must be renewed yearly.

The FAFSA can be filed electronically. A student must obtain a PIN number in order to do so.

Veterans Educational Benefits

Students who wish to use veterans educational benefits must first be accepted at UNCW before their benefits can be determined.

Students requesting VA benefits for the first time will need a registered, certified copy of their DD Form 214. Students who have previously used their VA benefits also need their last VA Award Letter, their VA file number, and the Change of Program form. Additional documentation may also be required depending upon the type of VA educational benefits in use.

Financial assistance may also be available to students who are receiving VA educational benefits. These students should also file the FAFSA.

Tuition Assistance
