UNCW Main Campus and Extension Graduations

Extension students have the option of graduating from the UNCW main campus in Wilmington, at the Extension Campus in Jacksonville, or at both locations!

Main Campus - Graduation at the main campus is held twice a year (December and May).

Extension Campus - Camp Lejeune holds a special graduation for all the schools on base once a year (May only). Students that graduate in Fall and/or Spring are permitted to participate in the Extension Graduation.

UNCW Graduation Deadlines & Application (All Campuses)

In order to graduate from UNCW (main campus or extension), you must fill out a graduation application. Visit <http://www.uncw.edu/stuaff/transitions/commencement.htm> for details. You will not receive a diploma unless you complete the application.

UNCW Graduation Tickets (Main Campus)

All guests, including infants, are required to have a ticket for the Main Campus graduation. Tickets will be issued to graduates at the UNCW Bookstore (only after they present proper photo identification). *The number of tickets is limited.* Contact the UNCW Bookstore at 910-962-3188 for details.

UNCW Extension Graduation (Camp Lejeune)

If you are able to participate in the Onslow County graduation ceremony, please complete the UNCW Onslow County Extension Program *Reservation Form & Exit Survey*. We need to confirm the exact number of graduates and guests who will be attending. At this time, there is no limit to the number of guests that you can invite to attend to the Extension Graduation. Please note that only students classified as "Extension Students" with the main campus will be listed in the extension graduation program.

Regalia (Cap & Gown)

Main Campus - Graduation candidates are provided caps, gowns, distinction cords and master's degree hoods at no additional charge. Caps, gowns and master's degree hoods are available for pick up at the UNCW Bookstore. Contact the UNCW Bookstore at 910-962-3188 to find out how and when to register for your cap and gown.

Extension - You should plan to wear your cap and gown from your main campus graduation ceremony. If you did not attend the graduation ceremony at the main campus, contact the UNCW Bookstore at 910-962-3188 to arrange make arrangements to register and to pickup your cap and gown.
