



## Bachelor of Social Work

The University of North Carolina Wilmington, Onslow Extension Program, in partnership with the North Carolina Community College System, offers a Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) that can be completed entirely in Jacksonville, NC.

Online and face-to-face courses are available and offered in Jacksonville at Coastal Carolina Community College and at the John A. Lejeune Education Center aboard Camp Lejeune. Area residents, military, and military dependents have access to these courses.

### Career Opportunities in Social Work

The Department of Social Work offers a Bachelor of Social Work degree that prepares students for an entry-level social work position in many public and private social agencies. Such agencies include family services programs, schools, hospitals, departments of social services, hospices, nursing homes, health care services, mental health agencies and other programs and services for children and adults.

### UNCW Application Information

- Prospective students must meet criteria for admission to UNCW and must apply through the normal application process. View the admissions website [www.uncw.edu/admissions](http://www.uncw.edu/admissions) for details.
- Students may transfer a maximum of 64 semester hour credits from two-year institutions or a maximum of 93 semester credit hours from four-year institutions.
- Students admitted to UNCW Extension degree programs, as extension transfer students, must have completed a minimum of 24 college credits (from any college in the North Carolina Community College System or other accredited institutions).
- Application deadline is **March 1** for Summer and Fall classes and **November 1** for Spring classes.

- In addition to admission to UNCW, the Social Work Program admissions requirements include:
  - A transfer, must earn a 2.40 GPA to be admitted into the Field Practicum which is required for completion of the requirements for the BSW degree
  - Must maintain a "C" or better in all social work (SWK) courses
