



Teacher Licensure Elementary Education

For students who currently hold a bachelor's degree, and seek a teaching license, the University of North Carolina Wilmington, Onslow Extension Program, offers a Teacher Licensure Program for Elementary Education. This licensure program can be completed entirely in Jacksonville, NC.

Online and face-to-face courses are available and offered in Jacksonville at Coastal Carolina Community College and at the John A. Lejeune Education Center aboard Camp Lejeune. Area residents, military, and military dependents have access to these courses.

Career Opportunities in Elementary Education

The Watson School of Education is dedicated to the preparation of teachers and other professionals to work with elementary school children as well as promoting reading, language development, cognitive, and learning skills. The Teacher Licensure Program in elementary education prepares the student for a licensure to teach grades K-6.

- Prospective students must meet criteria for admission to UNCW and must apply through the normal application process. View the admissions website www.uncw.edu/admissions for details.
- Application deadline is **March 1** for Summer and Fall classes and **November 1** for Spring classes.

UNCW Watson School of Education Information

- For admission in the Watson School of Education students must meet the following requirements:
 - Passed Praxis I (reading, writing, and math)
 - Graduated with a minimum 2.70 cumulative GPA requirement on bachelor's degree
 - Completed university requirements in English, Math, and one Laboratory Science course ("C" or better)
 - Students must comply with the Watson School of Education's *Standards of Professional Conduct*
 - Completed EDN 200 + EDNL 200 with a grade of "C" or better, and a minimum of 12 semester hours of UNCW credit
