

Summer Financial Aid 2017

At UNCW, the academic year begins with the fall semester, followed by the spring semester, and ends with summer sessions. The summer is considered a “trailer” for the majority of undergraduate and graduate programs at the University.

Summer financial aid is based on your remaining eligibility for the academic year. If you borrowed your [annual loan limit](#) during the preceding fall and spring semesters, the parent [PLUS loan](#) (dependent students only) or a [private/nonfederal loan](#) may be an option.

To be considered for summer 2017 Financial Aid, you must:

- Be accepted for admission by the university and enrolled in an eligible degree program. Visiting students are *not* eligible for financial aid.
- Complete the [2016-2017 Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#). The 2016-2017 FAFSA is available online through June 30, 2017.
- Be making [satisfactory academic progress](#) after spring grades post (continuing or re-enrolling students)
- Complete the [Summer Aid Application](#).
- Enroll in the minimum credit hours to receive Federal Loans
 - Undergraduates – 6 Credit hours
 - Graduate students 4.5 Credit hours
