2008 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

The Radio & Television News Directors Association of the Carolinas (RTNDAC) is pleased to announce its 2008 college scholarship competition. RTNDAC will award two \$1,000 scholarships for the 2008-09 academic year, to two currently-enrolled rising juniors or seniors in the Carolinas, who are pursuing a major course of study with emphasis in broadcast or electronic journalism. A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified student attending a college or university in North Carolina, and another \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified student enrolled in a college or university in South Carolina.

The deadline is October 1, 2008.

Although there is no formal application form, to be eligible for consideration a scholarship application must contain the following information:

- Name of applicant.
- Year in school.
- Home and school address of the applicant, and telephone numbers.
- College major.
- College honors, offices and activities.
- High school attended and any honors, offices and activities.
- Any other accomplishments or information the applicant would like to provide.
- A statement (one-page minimum) signed by the applicant, telling how the scholarship would contribute toward the applicant's future career goals.
- The names, addresses and telephone numbers of at least two references. Recommendation letters from each of the references are to be sent under separate cover directly to the Scholarship Chair.
- A certified copy of the applicant's transcript sent under separate cover directly to the Scholarship Chair.
