This application for scholarships administered by the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures is **due March 31, 2008**. Please submit a hard copy of this completed form with attachments as indicated to **Leutze Hall 279**.

The following scholarships are awarded to **majors in Foreign Languages or outstanding foreign language students in less commonly taught languages**. Please indicate by an **X** the scholarship(s) for which you are applying. **You may apply for as many scholarships as you qualify for.**

____ **The Helena R. Cheek Scholarship.** This scholarship is awarded **to students majoring in a foreign language (French, German, or Spanish)** who demonstrate special ability in the area of foreign language study and overall academic excellence. In most years, two scholarships for \$500 - \$600 each are awarded.

____ **Text Book Scholarships.** In most years, two scholarships for \$160 each are awarded **to students majoring in a foreign language (French, German, or Spanish)**.

____ **The Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures Academic Scholarship.** This scholarship is awarded to a student who demonstrates special ability in the area of foreign language study and overall academic excellence. In most years, one award of \$500 is awarded. **Students studying any language are eligible to apply for this scholarship—it is not necessary to major in a foreign language.**

NOTE: These are merit-based scholarships. Recipients will be selected solely taking into account achievement in the area of foreign language study and overall academic accomplishments.

To apply for these scholarships, the student must:

- be enrolled full-time.
- have declared a major in a foreign language (**for the Helena R. Cheek and Text Book Scholarships**).
- be a student enrolled in any foreign language (**for the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures Academic Scholarship**).
- have completed 48 college/university semester credit hours at the time of application.
- have completed a minimum of 24 semester credit hours at UNCW at the time of application.
- have a **minimum overall GPA of 3.0 and a minimum 3.3 GPA in the foreign language major** (**for the Helena R. Cheek and Text Book Scholarships**).
- have a **minimum overall GPA of 3.0 and a minimum 3.3 GPA in foreign language courses for majors and non-majors** (**for the Foreign Language and Literatures Academic Scholarship**).
