<b>Univ. de la Réunion</b>	<b>La Réunion</b>	<b>EX</b>	<b>AY, F, S</b>
The university is located in the heart of the Indian Ocean, in the French territory of La Reunion. French language and French translation courses are offered in addition to regular classes for intermediate to advanced levels.			
<b>Moulay Ismail Univ.</b>	<b>Morocco</b>	<b>SA</b>	<b>AY, F, S</b>
A year, semester or summer program is available in Meknès, home to the beautiful blend of the Arab, Berber, and French cultures composing modern Morocco. Language classes are modular and students may progress through two courses in a semester.			
<b>Suffolk University-Dakar</b>	<b>Senegal</b>	<b>SA</b>	<b>AY, F, S</b>
This Program offers students the opportunity to live and study in a Francophone West African country, where they are encouraged to use their French language skills in everyday settings. Conversation Partners are also available.			

### Americas

Univ. des Antilles et de la Guyane	French Guiana	EX	AY, F, S
Exchange programs are available at the Université des Antilles et de la Guyane (UAG), which is the only French university in the Caribbean. Students may choose to study at one of the three UAG locations - French Guiana, Guadeloupe, or Martinique. French as a Second Language (F.L.E.) is taught in Martinique at the Institute for Francophone Studies (ISEF).			

### Europe
