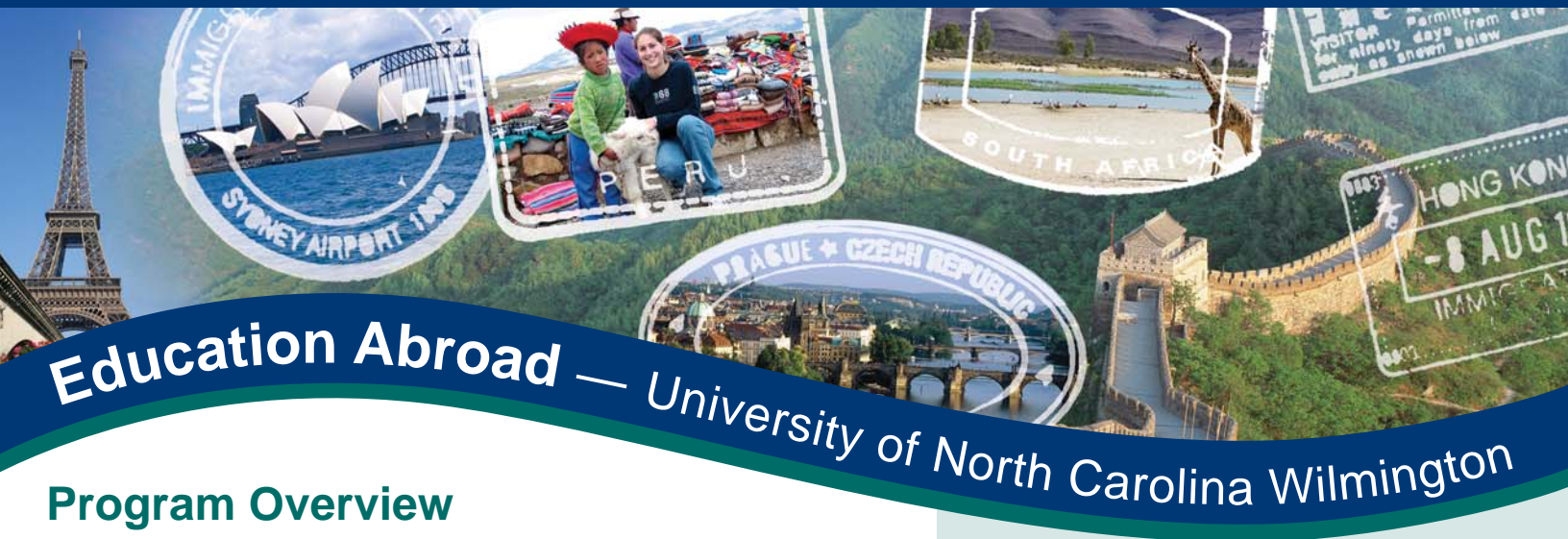

Cost

This program is available as an Exchange or as a Study Abroad:

- Exchange – This means you pay your regular tuition and fees to UNCW, and your room and board to NUI Maynooth.
- Study Abroad – This means you pay your tuition, fees, room and board abroad

With each option, there will be additional costs for international airfare, passport, health insurance, local transportation
