

SPANISH MAJOR WORKSHEET
REQUIREMENTS FOR A B.A. DEGREE IN SPANISH
(36 hours)

I. 6 Semester hours:

- SPN 202 **Intermediate II** (prerequisite: SPN 201 or equivalent)
203 **Intermediate Reading** (prerequisite: SPN 202 or equivalent)

II. A minimum of 24 semester hours chosen from the following:

- SPN 305 **Conversation and Composition** (prerequisite: SPN 203 or equivalent)
306 **Advanced Grammar** (prerequisite: SPN 203 or equivalent)
307 **Phonetics** (prerequisite: SPN 203 or equivalent)
308 **Hispanic Linguistics** (prerequisite: SPN 203 and 307 or equivalent)
310 **Business Spanish** (prerequisite: SPN 203 and 305)
311 **Spanish Civilization** (prerequisites: SPN 203 and 305)
312 **Spanish-American Civilization** (prerequisites: SPN 203 and 305)
321 **Introduction to Spanish Literature** (prerequisites: both SPN 203 and 305)
322 **Introduction to Spanish-American Literature** (prerequisites: both SPN 203 and 305)
323 **Introduction to US Latino Literature & Culture** (prerequisites: both SPN 203 and 305 or equivalent)
385 **Introduction to Spanish Cinema** (Course conducted in English)

III. A minimum of 6 semester hours chosen from the following:

- SPN 401 **Translation Techniques and Practices** (prerequisites: native or near-native command of Written English, SPN 203, SPN 306, and one additional Spanish course at the 300-level or above)
405 **Advanced Conversation and Composition** (prerequisite: SPN 305 or equivalent)
407 **Topic in Spanish Phonetics and Phonology** (prerequisite: SPN 307 and 308 or equivalent)
408 **Topic in Spanish Linguistics** (prerequisite: SPN 307 and 308 or equivalent) Advanced study of Hispanic Linguistics. Topics will focus on the history of the Spanish language, Spanish applied linguistics, and dialectology.
411 **Topics in Spanish Civilization** (prerequisite: SPN 311 or equivalent); variable content; may be repeated under a different subtitle.
412 **Topics in Spanish-American Civilization** (prerequisite: SPN 312 or equivalent); variable content; may be repeated under a different subtitle.
421 **Studies in Spanish Literature** (prerequisite: SPN 321 or equivalent); variable content; may be repeated under a different subtitle.
422 **Studies in Spanish-American Literature** (prerequisite: SPN 322 or equivalent); variable content; may be repeated under a different subtitle.
485 **Seminar in Spanish Cinema** (prerequisite: A 300-level course in Spanish, Course conducted in English)
491 **Directed Individual Study** (prerequisite: overall GPA of at least 2.00, junior or senior standing, and consent of instructor, department chairperson, and dean)
495 **Seminar in Hispanic Studies** (prerequisite: SPN 321 or 322 or equivalent); variable content; may be repeated under a different subtitle.
498 **Internship in Spanish** (prerequisite: junior standing, completion of at least 12 hours of course work in SPN at the 300 or 400 level, and consent of instructor)
499 **Honors Work in Spanish** (prerequisite: eligibility for honors program and senior standing)

--In the last semester before graduation, Spanish majors are expected to take two exit assessment exams, one in reading and the other in speaking/listening. Your advisor can give you information on when and how these are administered.

--A 400-level course may be substituted for one of the required eight 300-level courses.

--All classes, with the exception of SPN 491, 495 and 499 are for 3 hours of credit. SPN 491 and 495 may be taken for 1-3 credits. SPN 499 may be taken for 2-3 credits.

--No more than three credit hours total of 498 and 491 may be counted toward the Spanish major. (In other words, the student may count 491 or 498 (but not both) toward the major.
