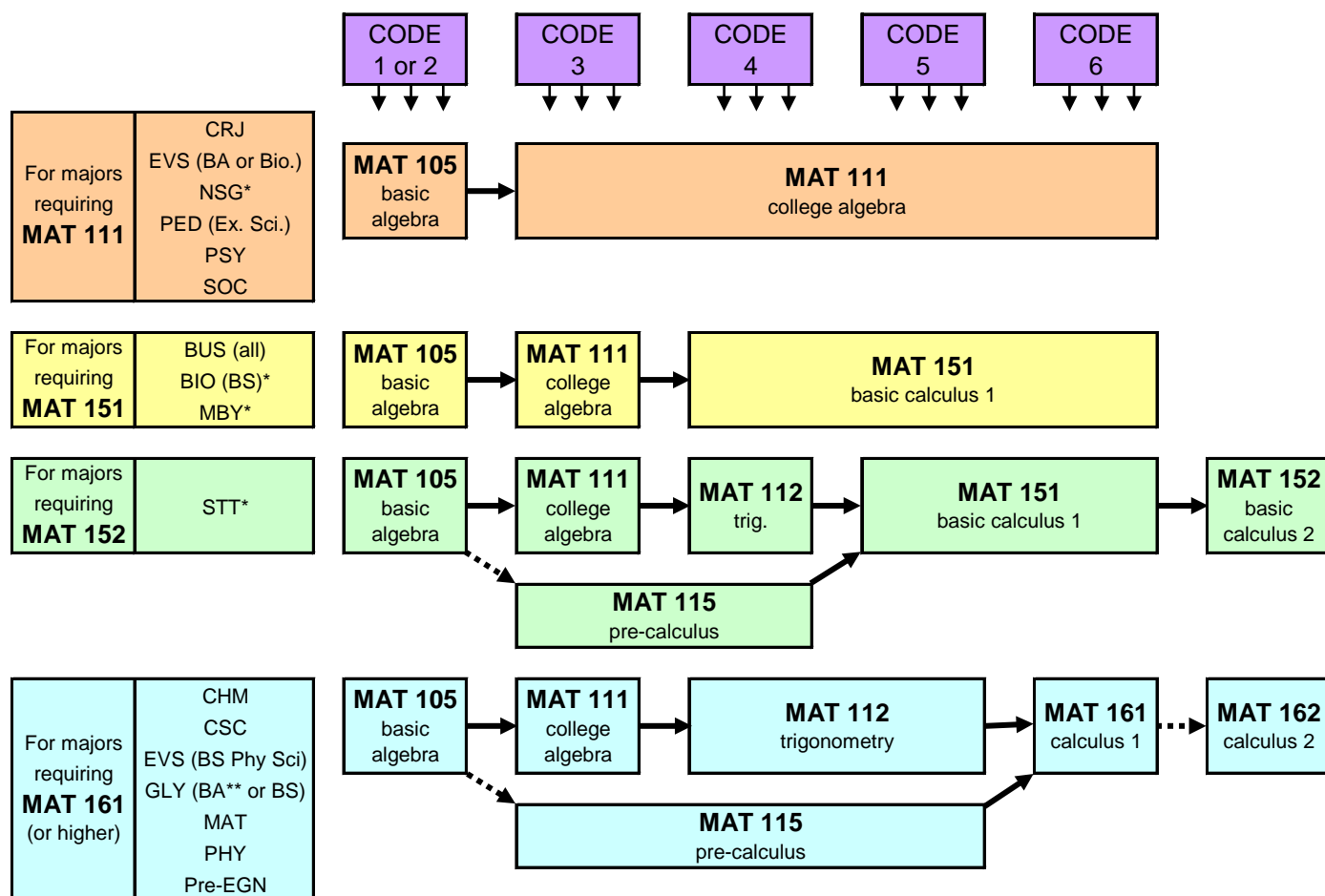


Mathematics Placement Test Codes, Suggested First Courses, and Course Tracks for Given Majors

This chart identifies the first mathematics course and the path of the successive required courses for various majors. It is strongly recommended that students begin with the course (in the appropriate track) indicated by their placement test code, but students can begin to the left (but not the right) of the course suggested.



* These tracks meet the minimum requirements for these majors. Alternate tracks are sometimes appropriate for more advanced studies.

** Students majoring in Geology (BA) may start with the course corresponding to their placement code and stop when they've fulfilled the requirements.

1 MAT 141-142 require a 2 on the math placement.

2 MAT 151 **does not** fulfill the prerequisite requirements for MAT 161 or 162, but MAT 161 **does** fulfill the prerequisite requirements for MAT 152.

3 For all majors requiring MAT 111 or 151, any higher-numbered MAT course (except MAT 141 or MAT 142) will satisfy the requirement.

4 MAT 101 does not require a placement score and is not a preparation for other MAT courses.

5 MAT 105 is generally not intended as a preparation for MAT 101 or MAT 141.
