Application for admission to the university is through the Office of Admissions. All applicants are encouraged to apply to UNCW before January 1 and audition before April 1 whenever possible.

Admission to the Music Program is determined by an acceptable level of performance as demonstrated through a personal audition on the major applied instrument. A satisfactory audition is required of all entering freshman and transfer students. Audition appointments are made by completing this form and returning it to the UNCW Department of Music (address listed at the beginning and end of this application). Should it be impossible to audition on campus due to extreme distance or other extenuating circumstances, it is permissible to send a cassette tape or CD recording (see the Music Department website for more information: www.uncw.edu/music). Admission to the Music Program is also contingent upon the applicant's admission into the university. The applicant must also complete a university application before an audition appointment will be confirmed.

2009-2010 Audition Dates

Auditions will be held at the University of North Carolina Wilmington on the dates listed below. Applicants are strongly encouraged to audition on one of these dates. However, applicants who cannot attend on these dates may request a special audition on an alternate date. For vocal auditions on all scheduled dates, a piano accompanist will be provided. The completed audition application form is due no later than 5:00 pm, three business days prior to your first chosen audition date. It is recommended, but not required, that applicants provide two letters of recommendation for their audition. Recommendation letters are required for music scholarship auditions. Letters of reference may be sent with this application or under a separate cover via mail, fax, or email. Once your university application is complete, you will be notified of the time and location of the audition.
