

AGA DIVATOR FULL-FACE DIVING MASK



APPLICATION: [Wet-diving] The full-face diving mask is primarily used with the wireless communication system to allow underwater diver-to-diver and/or diver-to-surface voice communication. Full-face diving masks are also used in high current or diver-towed situations where the chances of losing the regulator or facemask from a diver's face must be precluded. The mask can be used with scuba or surface supplied gear.

DESCRIPTION: The AGA MK II lightweight full-face mask features a wide faceplate, positive pressure regulator (3 psi over ambient), an oral-nasal mask, waterproof microphone, bone-conducting earphone, and a "spider"-retaining retaining strap.
