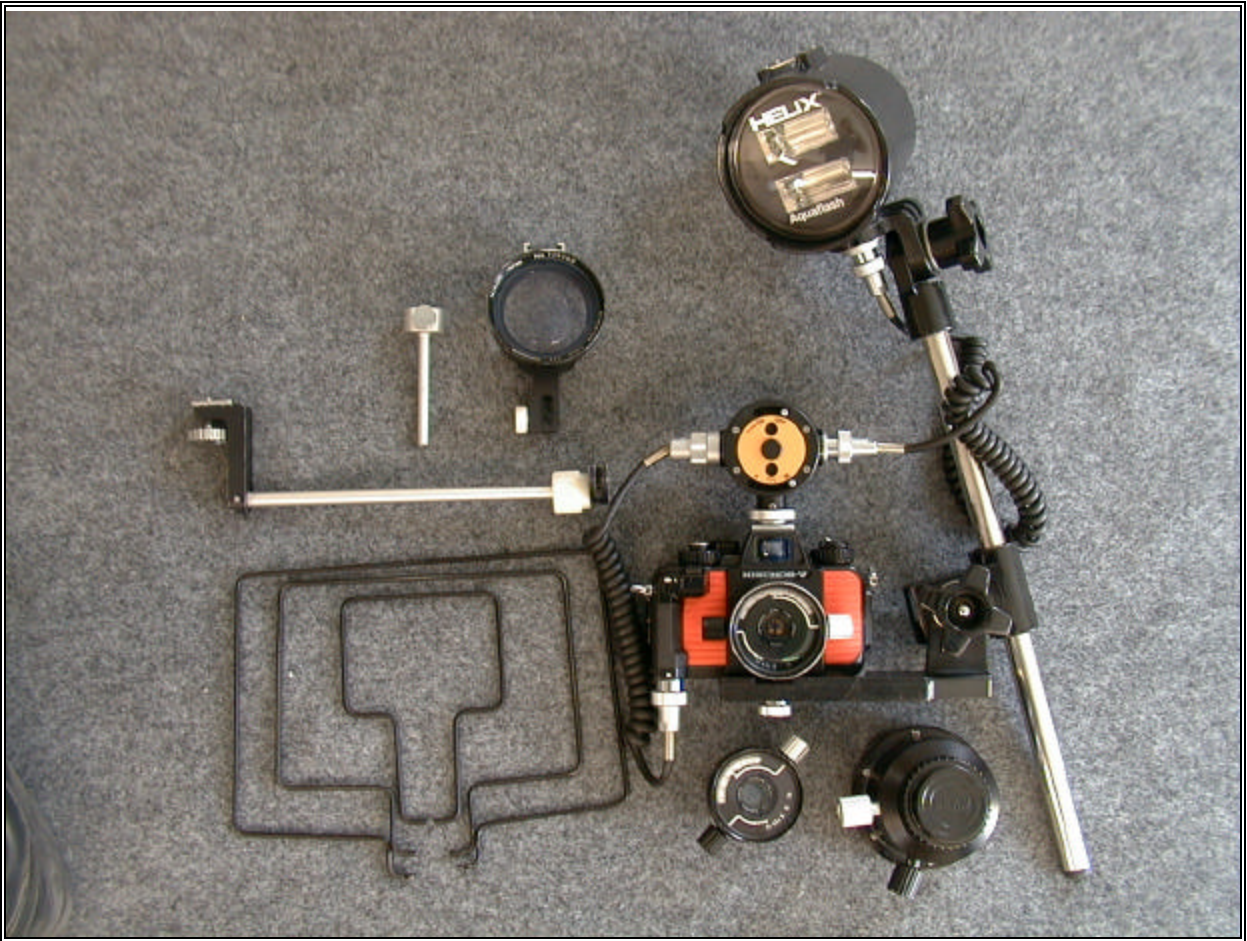


UNDERWATER STILL CAMERA/STROBE



APPLICATION: [Wet Diving] Still cameras are used for underwater photographic documentation. Strobe/flash units are utilized to light the subject and bring out color in the underwater environment. The camera uses standard 36 exposure cassettes of either slide or picture film. A variety of lenses and attachments are available for close-up, wide angle, and macro photography.

DESCRIPTION: The Nikonos V underwater camera is depth rated to 160 FSW. The camera has automatic aperture-priority and manual exposure control settings. A second “slave” strobe can be added for more light capability. Lenses available include 15mm, 28mm, 35mm, 85mm, close-up diopters, and macro. A Nikonos II unit is also available. **These cameras are operated and maintained by qualified NURC staff only.** Scientists requiring photographic documentation must either accompany the staff diver or give explicit details on what is to be photographed.
