Time Management Apps

Name	Cost	Description
MyHomework Student Planner iPhone Android	Free	MyHomework Student Planner will help you never miss another course, lecture or lab, track tasks and deadlines, plan homework, and arrange assignments. Syncs with calendar to help prevent scheduling two things at the same time.
My Study Life iPhone Android	Free	My Study Life is a planner that stores your homework and exams. You can track your homework and assignments, and get notification reminders for unfinished tasks, upcoming exams and classes before they even start.
Wunderlist iPhone Android	Free	Wunderlist allows you to organize to-do lists and tasks. You can set priority levels for each task. For group projects, task lists can be shared and managed by multiple users.
Exam Countdown iPhone	Free	Exam Countdown allows you to keep track of your exam dates with a daily countdown. Set reminders in advance, and countdown until right before you take your exam.
30/30 Study Checker iPhone Android	Free	30/30 Task Manager (iPhone) and Study Checker (Android) allows you to keep track of how much time you spend on each task. Set up a list of tasks and a length of time for each. When you start the timer, it will tell you when to move on to the next task.

Note Taking Apps

Name	Cost	Description
Dropbox iPhone Android	Free	Dropbox lets you bring all your documents, photos, and videos anywhere and share them easily. After you install Dropbox on your computer, any file you save to your Dropbox will automatically save to all your devices. With the Dropbox app, you can access papers, school work, and notes from any mobile device.
Evernote iPhone Android	Free	Evernote helps you remember everything across all of the devices you use. Take notes, capture photos, create to-do lists, and record voice reminders. This app helps you stay organized, saves your ideas, and improves your productivity. Sort your notes by subject and share with classmates.
Simple Outliner iPhone WorkFlowy Android	Free	Simple Outliner (iPhone) and WorkFlowy (Android) lets you organize notes, tasks, and projects, and create to-do lists for today, or track an entire project. The app includes an editor tool, which enables you to make quick changes to documents.

inClass iPhone	Free	inClass will help you organize your schedule and share your notes. It will help you keep track of your tasks by reminding you that one is due soon. inClass will help you take notes more efficiently with either video notes, audio notes, or photo notes. Once you start taking notes, inClass will know which class you are in.
Google Drive iPhone Android	Free	Group projects are a regular part of college life, and Google Drive makes collaborating on these projects a breeze. You can use the app to create, share and collectively edit presentations, spreadsheets and documents. Google Drive allows you to edit any document, regardless of when it was created.

EasyBib iPhone Android	Free	EasyBib allows you to create accurate MLA, APA, and Chicago style citations in seconds by scanning a book bar code or by typing the name of a book. You can build and manage your work cited page.
RefME iPhone Android	Free	RefME allows you to create citations, bibliographies and reference lists including APA, MLA, Harvard, and OSCOLA formats.

Study Aid Apps

StudyBlue iPhone Android	Free	StudyBlue allows you to create your own notes, study guides, quizzes, and flashcards, and then access them anywhere. Contact classmates directly from inside the app, allowing you to have discussions, ask questions, and share flashcards.
Flashcards iPhone Android	Free	Flashcards allows you to create flashcards to study for any class or standardized test. This app feels like a real deck of flashcards and does not get in your way. You can also email your flashcard decks or share them using Dropbox.
