

**STUDY ABROAD IN THE HEART OF EUROPE

Curriculum:

Study undergraduate or masters-level **Political Science** and **Public Administration** with additional courses in **Communications** (Leadership, the Knowledge Economy), **Business** (International Economics, International Economic Policy), and **German** (Beginning, Intermediate, and Advanced). Past courses have included: Comparative Governance, National Governance, European Governance, Political Theory, Climate Change Diplomacy, Non-profit Management, and Public Management. You can earn a full semester of credits.

Location:

Friedrichshafen, where Zeppelin is located, is a resort town on the shores of Lake Constance, at the border of Germany, Switzerland, and France. Around Lake Constance are opportunities for skating, water/skiing, snowboarding, boating, hiking, and cycling (including the 160-mile round the lake cycle route). Nearby find baroque churches, ancient abbeys, museums, and the scenic Black Forest. Weekends, travel by train to Munich (3 hours), Zurich (2 ½ hours), Strasbourg (3 hours) or northern Italy (4 hours). For a longer getaway, consider Paris (6 ½ hours) or Berlin (6 ½ hours). Discount air carrier Ryanair connects the Friedrichshafen airport with London, Dublin, and other European destinations.

Duration: Fall or Spring semester

Cost: Pay your regular tuition at UNCW, study in Europe

Due date: Apply by October 1 for Spring
