Objectives Covered:

2.01—Evaluate data related to population growth, along with problems and solutions: disease control

--this activity is a good segway into Melissa's Epidemic/Pandemic activity.

Procedure:

There are some word documents that have articles about the Bubonic Plague and resistance. There are differing levels of complexity so the teacher can choose which they think their students can understand. The word documents can be used to introduce the students to the Bubonic Plague or as a follow up to the PowerPoint.

The PowerPoint just goes through how the Plague is spread and how it is treated and also goes into some of the more recent cases. Hopefully it will get the students thinking about how diseases are controlled in modern times.

Follow this with Melissa's Endemic/Pandemic activity or have it stand on its own.
