The next full meeting of the GK-12 program will take place on **Tuesday, March 15<sup>th</sup>**. Note the change in location.

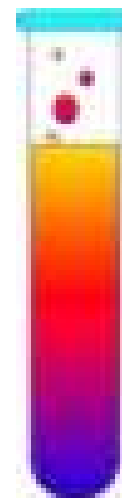
