Degree Audit

What is a degree audit?

A degree audit provides the student and advisor an analysis of degree requirements for a particular degree, major, minor or certificate program. It is a tool to assist the student and advisor in monitoring the student's progress towards a degree and planning future coursework. The degree audit is an internal document for advising purposes and is not an official document of your academic record at UNC Wilmington.
