| <p><b>METALS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Aluminum – <i>cans, foil...</i></li> <li>✓ Steel – <i>cans, lids, nails, screws...</i></li> <li>✓ Tin - <i>cans</i></li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Place all items in “can” section of Multi-bin.</li> </ul>  |
| <p><b>PLASTICS</b> - <i>clear and all colors</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Milk, detergent, juice jugs...</li> <li>✓ Soda, water bottles...</li> <li>✓ Lids</li> <li>✓ Bubble wrap</li> <li>✓ Grocery bags</li> <li>✓ Transparencies</li> </ul> <p><b>No Styrofoam</b></p>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ We recycle type <b>1, 2, 3 &amp; 4 type plastic</b>. Place in “plastic bottle” section of Multi-bin.</li> <li>➤ Containers should be empty with lid REMOVED.</li> </ul>  |
| <p><b>GLASS</b> - <i>clear and all colors</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Bottles, jars...</li> <li>✓ Broken windows, basketball backboards...</li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Place all items in “mixed glass” section of Multi-bin.</li> <li>➤ Large amounts of <b>BROKEN GLASS</b> - place in a bucket or box and submit a Work Order on Ubusiness for special pick-up. This service is FREE!</li> </ul>   |
| <p><b>PAPER</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Books - <i>paperbacks, hardbacks, textbooks, phonebooks, magazines, notebooks...</i></li> <li>✓ Bags - <i>brown paper, pet food bags...</i></li> <li>✓ Boxes*</li> <li>✓ Calendars</li> <li>✓ Carbonless Paper</li> <li>✓ Cards - <i>greeting cards, index cards...</i></li> <li>✓ Chipboard -<i>cracker boxes, cereal boxes...</i></li> <li>✓ Computer and copier paper</li> <li>✓ Corrugated cardboard</li> <li>✓ Envelopes - <i>with or without windows</i></li> <li>✓ Folders - <i>manila, file folders...</i></li> <li>✓ Junk Mail</li> <li>✓ Newspaper</li> <li>✓ Notebook paper - <i>stapled, clipped or bound</i></li> <li>✓ Poster board</li> <li>✓ Post-It Notes</li> <li>✓ Shredded paper*</li> <li>✓ Tissue paper</li> </ul> <p><b>No Kleenex</b></p> <p><b>No Items with food on it</b> -<i>pizza boxes...</i></p> <p><b>No Carbon Paper</b></p> <p><b>No Wax Paper</b></p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ If you have <b>boxes, books, magazines</b>, or unusual amounts of paper submit a Work Order on Ubusiness for a special pick-up. This service is FREE!</li> <li>➤ <b>BOXES – Flatten and place behind Multi-bin in your building. Large amounts of cardboard/boxes can be taken to:</b><br/>Lionfish Drive - <i>next door to University Police</i><br/>Dobo – <i>dock area</i><br/>Watson – <i>service entrance area</i><br/>Cameron – <i>south entrance area</i><br/>Library – <i>loading dock</i><br/>Trask – <i>loading dock</i><br/>Alderman – <i>first floor entrance near Hoggard</i><br/>Warwick – <i>dumpster area</i><br/>Fisher – <i>loading dock, dumpster area</i></li> <li>➤ <b>SHREDDED PAPER – Bag and place beside Multi-bin in your building.</b></li> <li>➤ Tear <b>pizza box</b> in half and recycle part with no food on it.</li> </ul> |
| <p><b>BATTERIES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Rechargeable batteries</li> <li>✓ Button batteries</li> <li>✓ Cell phone batteries</li> <li>✓ Lead acid batteries</li> <li>✓ UPS – <i>Uninterruptible Power Supply</i></li> </ul> <p><b>No Alkaline batteries</b></p>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>All batteries</b> - call EH&amp;S for pickup x7017.</li> <li>➤ UPS stops working? It is probably just the battery. You can replace the battery for about half the price of a new UPS.</li> <li>➤ <b>ALKALINE BATTERIES</b> - have been deemed safe for the landfill. We are no longer able to recycle these for free.</li> </ul>  |
| <p><b>TONER AND INK JET CARTRIDGES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Suggestions for cartridges</li> </ul>   | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Call <b>Warehouse Services</b> at x3621 to request pick-up.</li> <li>2. Binaries store in Fisher Student Union sells ink jet refills.</li> </ol>  |
