General information, degree requirements for all undergraduate majors and options in the Cameron School of Business, and detailed requirements for admission are listed in the undergraduate catalogue. The requirements for admission to the CSB are listed below:

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

1. Each applicant must have completed a minimum of **44 semester hours**.
2. Each applicant must have completed a Cameron School of Business Admission **Orientation** online.
3. Each applicant must submit an “on-line” Cameron School of Business Application.
4. Students must earn a minimum GPA of 2.6 for the Admission Cluster of courses:
 - Students entering as FRESHMEN must complete the following courses
 - ¹ENG 101-201 or 103 Composition (3-3 or 3)
 - ¹MAT 151 or 161 Calculus (3 or 4) Prerequisite: MAT 111 or 115
 - ¹QMM 280 Statistical Analysis for Business and Economics (3)
Prerequisite: MAT 111 or 115
 - ¹ACG 201 & ACGL 201 Financial Accounting & Lab (4) Prerequisite: MAT 111 or 115
 - ¹ECN 221 Principles of Economics - Micro (3) Prerequisite: MAT 111 or 115
 - ¹ECN 222 Principles of Economics - Macro (3) Prerequisite: ECN 221
 - One semester of a foreign language (3)
The Admission GPA will be calculated on these 25 credit hours.
 - Students entering as TRANSFERS must complete *at least 12 UNCW credit hours*:
 - A. Complete ALL of the courses listed above.
 - B. IF ADDITIONAL COURSES ARE NEEDED to complete at least 12 UNCW credit hours, the following courses may be used: ACG 203, BLA 361, ECN 324, FIN 335, MGT 350, MIS 213, MKT 340, and/or POM 370. All credit hours enrolled in during the semester in which 12 hours are completed from the Admission Cluster will be calculated for the Admission GPA.

 - ¹ACG 201 & ACGL 201 Financial Accounting & Lab (4) Pre- or co-requisite: MAT 111
 - ACG 203 Managerial Accounting (3) Prerequisite: ACG 201 & ACGL 201
 - QMM 280 Statistical Analysis for Business and Economics (3) Prerequisite: MAT 111
 - BLA 361 Legal Environment of Business (3) Junior or senior standing
 - MIS 213 Introduction to Information Systems and Technology (3)
 - ECN 324 Money and Capital Markets (3) Prerequisite: ECN 222
 - MGT 350 Principles of Management (3) Prerequisite: Junior standing
 - MKT 340 Principles of Marketing (3) Prerequisite: Junior standing
 - FIN 335 Principles of Financial Management (3) Prerequisites: ACG 203, ECN 222, QMM 280
 - POM 370 Introduction to Operations Management (3) Prerequisite: QMM 280
 - ²MGT 455 Business Policy (3) Prerequisites: BLA 361, ECN 324, FIN 335, MGT 350, MKT 340, POM 370, and 9 hours in concentration
6. Students may not enroll in restricted courses until accepted into the Cameron School of Business. A list of restricted classes may be found in the Cameron School of Business Student Services Center, Cameron Hall 121.
7. Students must earn a minimum GPA of 2.00 on all courses attempted in the CSB

A minimum grade of “C-” is required in each course counting toward the major, and students must earn a minimum GPA of “C” (2.00) in major courses.

Students who wish to pursue graduate studies (economics graduate school, law school, etc.) should consult a faculty advisor early in the major to identify elective courses outside the economics program that will aid them in gaining acceptance to graduate school.
